

N7 Engineering Academy Syllabus for MSC CSIs, CSIs, and SWIs

Course Content

This course provides an in-depth introduction to Military Sealift Command (MSC) class standard items (CSIs), cross-class standard items (CCSIs), and standardized work items (SWIs). The subject matter covered includes locating and downloading applicable CSI / CCSI / SWI templates from the SAMM Library Items module and editing templates to create biddable work items.

The target audience for this course is Principal Port Engineers (PPEs) and Assistant Port Engineers (APEs).

- MSC Work Item Writing Fundamentals course
- MSC Work Item Estimating Fundamentals course
